You may know that in Yoxford Cemetery are four war graves, and to acknowledge the sacrifice of these fallen soldiers. Council applied to the CWGC for a sign to be installed. The application has been accepted and is currently being processed. All being well, the sign should be erected within the next 10 months.

On a daily basis, funds continue to be raised by the tireless Ally Hackwell and these have been added to by the recent Quiz Night organised by Cllr. Dave Tower and Sheena Tower.
