**Sizewell C**. In joint working with eight other local parishes and villages, Yoxford Parish Council has signed a letter sent to Sizewell, East Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council.

The letter asks for substantial road improvements to cope with Sizewell C's 'Early Years' traffic. Should it go ahead, this traffic is planned to include up to 600 HGVs per day as well as all workers' cars and smaller good vehicles for the project for 2-3 years.
