## Village Matters

### Update following the floods since

**October 2023:** Work has begun in the village to minimise future flood impact. Landowners have been contacted and some are clearing ditches. Suffolk Highways is clearing drains. Yoxford Parish Council is linking with East Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council in the hope that pressure can be put on the Environment Agency to review the needs of the River Yox and carry out the required maintenance.

As previously reported, as a result of the significant flooding in the village, under the Flood and Water Management Act 2010, Suffolk County Council will undertake a Section 19 investigation. Yoxford Parish Council will contribute to this. **Maintaining village green areas:** Council is now considering tenders for grass cutting and additional maintenance of our green spaces. It's keen to improve the overall appearance of these areas and will oversee contractors and volunteers' work to ensure they are welcoming and useable spaces for everyone in the village.

**Planning Matters:** When a planning application is submitted and then validated by East Suffolk Council, **anyone can view and comment** on its <u>Public Access</u> system.

Yoxford Parish Council is a Consultee to every planning application that falls within the parish and, following discussion, will submit its comments. However, it has no decisionmaking power.

Other Consultees will be contacted directly and invited to comment by East Suffolk Council.
