Good afternoon

As promised, we would supply you with further details regarding the B1122 resurfacing works.

We will send a weekly progress update and our works tracker will be updated accordingly in the latest information section of the site.

The resurfacing works will commence on Tuesday 19th March, in the vicinity of Doughty Wylie Crescent in Theberton, working west along the B1122 towards Yoxford. We aim to complete up to 200m per night of carriageway resurfacing, which could vary depending on the design of new carriageway construction. The speed of the works is also affected by weather conditions as well as ground conditions. Following the carriageway resurfacing, our teams will complete improvements to the existing ironwork (gully and manhole covers), as well as complete road marking activities.

Typical access arrangements for residential access during the road closure will be as follows;

- 1. Resident approaches closed road (including the side roads) and notifies our teams (who will be stationed at the start of the closure), of access required to residence/business on B1122.
- 2. Our team will communicate via radio across the site, to confirm it is safe to access and from what direction.
- 3. If travelling away from work areas, resident's vehicle will be permitted access and asked to travel at low speeds (10mph) due to lorries using closed road.
- 4. If travelling to/through a work zone, an escort vehicle will travel to the side road and escort the resident's vehicle through to their required location.
